

General Rules and Guidelines

1. Each team will consist of three or four players (three starters and one substitute.)
2. Teams will be placed into divisions according to grade of their oldest player(s).
3. Roster changes are not allowed after the March 5 deadline unless approved by the tournament director(s).
4. All teams are guaranteed at least 3 scheduled games throughout the day.
5. Games will be played on a half court.
6. Scoring will be as follows: one point per basket, two points for shots made from beyond the 3-point arc. The first team to score 15 points, is leading by at least 2 points, or is the team ahead after 15 minutes, wins. If the game is tied after 15 minutes, then the game ends as a tie. There is no overtime. There will be no time limit for playoffs. Possession will alternate after each basket.
7. Tournament director(s) reserve the right to reduce the number of scheduled games or shorten games due to unforeseen circumstances.
8. Tournament director(s) reserve the right to combine certain divisions if a lack of entries exists.
9. Tournament officials reserve the right to refuse entry, eject players, teams, or fans from the tournament without refund for any conduct deemed unfit for public/family welfare.

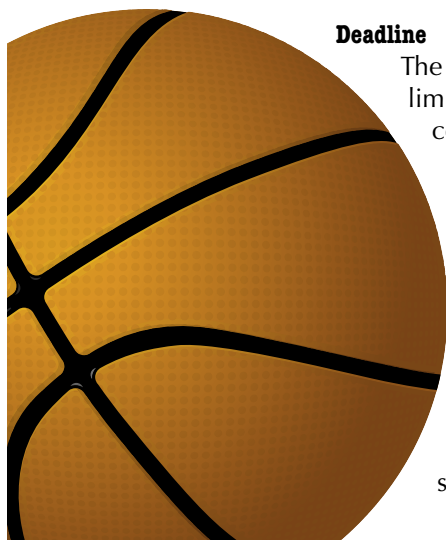
