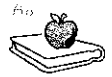

Mail Carriers for the 2010-11 school year will be the **oldest/only** students.



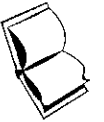

Boxtops for Education - Please continue to collect boxtops for our school. More information on upcoming contests will be coming soon!











Remember, to help keep our school clean, dark soda/pop or red colored juice is not allowed for snack, lunches or school parties.
